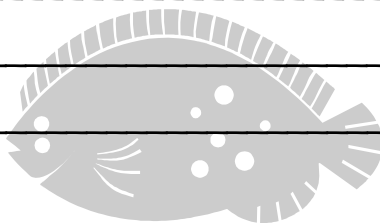
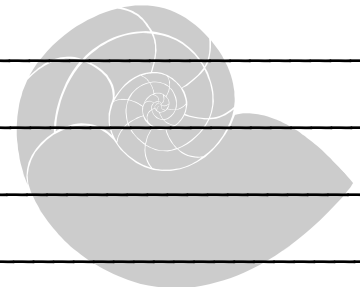

Possible Answers to Scavenger Hunt - Note: These are just some of the possible answers, your student may find other animals that meet the criteria listed.

1. Any of the Crustaceans, including crabs, lobsters, shrimp
2. Any Shark
3. Cuttlefish, Corals, Sea jellies (also called jelly fish), Anemones
4. Sea Horses
5. Any of the Bivalves: Scallops, Limpets, Snails, Conch, Chitons
6. Sea stars, Sea Urchin, Pufferfish, Lionfish
7. Moray Eel, Electric Eel, Ribbon Eel
8. Electric Eel, Paddlefish
9. African Lungfish, Mud Skippers, Gar, Bowfin
10. Pufferfish, Lionfish, Stonefish, Toadfish
11. Pufferfish or Swell Sharks
12. Any of the Echinoderms: Sea Stars, Sea Urchins, Sea Cucumbers,
13. Peacock Flounder, Leaf Fish, Batfish, Toadfish, Sea Horses
14. Lookdowns, Silversides, Striper Bass
15. Lionfish, Alligator Gar, Seahorse, Batfish, Toadfish, Catfish
16. Most of the Molluscs: Abalones, Whelks, Conchs, Scallops, Mussels; Sea Urchins; Lobsters; Crabs; Shrimp, Catfish, Bass etc.
17. Peacock Flounder, Lookdowns
18. Corals, Sea Anemones, Pufferfish, Stingrays, Sea Jellies
19. Sponges, Sea Anemones, Corals, Sea Jellies, Sea stars
